### Ginger Garff Talks About Her Recent Solar Panel Installation

"We've met more of our neighbors since November, when we installed a 4.7 kW PV system on our new garage, than in the entire five years since we moved in. Everyone wants to know about it, asks if it works in Seattle (Yes! Since May, we've been receiving credits instead of electric bills!), and about half of them leave thinking they might look into it. With all of the incentives currently in place, it looks like our payback time will be under 7 years. Installation was by Sunergy Systems in Ballard, and we couldn't have been happier."

## What's In Design

### Greenfire Campus

The Greenfire Campus, situated at the center of Ballard is ideally suited to contribute to a growing eco-district in this part of Seattle.

Several themes are woven through the design of the Greenfire Campus specifically geared for a variety of activities. The buildings on site consist of an office building and an apartment building each sitting above subgrade parking. The remainder of the site houses water storage cisterns, a pea patch, decks, plazas, two driveways and a riparian zone designed to provide bird habitat and to infiltrate water through rain gardens.



The sustainable theme of the campus combines "Sensible Sustainability" with "Social Sustainability". The goal is to create buildings and site treatments that are diverse and reasonable in cost assuming a long term investment. The inclusion of the natural environment as part of the living experience promotes the project's goal social interaction amongst residents and workers.
